SICK CHILDREN

If a child is sick, then parents/ carers should be informed immediately and asked to collect their child.

If any child has a communicable disease, then we should be informed by the parents/ carers and the child kept away until we have formed an action plan for integration.

If we are informed about a communicable disease, then we need to inform other users about possible contamination.

If the illness is serious, I.e. suspected meningitis, we shall inform the relevant Health Department and await instruction on procedure.

If a child becomes seriously ill or has an accident, then emergency services shall be called and the parent/carer shall be contacted and children will be cleared of the area.
